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# Thundering Event #4

# Papal Power <u>Acknowledged</u> Universal Sunday Law Enacted

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#### In a Few Words—

The seven thunders (last-day events) are *based* on *Daniel's fulfilled prophetic events* of the past. In the order of Daniel's literal <u>time</u> prophecies, the <u>first event</u> would be:

**The Fourth Thunder** —This is a universal Sunday law, a *One World Government Law*, with two stages; 1) The fourth thunder is an *enactment* phase; and 2) the fifth thunder is an *enforcement* phase. This thirty day, two-phase law, will be used as a time for the nations of the world to *decide if* they want to *join* the New World Order. Daniel wrote the prophecy of the *abomination of desolation* and Jesus placed it as the main crisis (Matt 24:15) during the last-day events of the last generation (Matt 23:36; 24:30, 33, 34.). This law is called the *abomination of desolation* for good reason, and in reality; there will NOT be a *free choice* given, —to any nation or individual! Force will be the end result used by the right arm (the U.S.) of the Papacy. Preparation for setting up the Papacy and its image (Universal Sunday Law) will require the liquidation of three nations (and the absorption and reorganization of others).

#### What is the Desolation?—

The world will be so deceived by the events of the anti-Christ that they won't even see the end coming. The definition of the *Strong's Hebrew* word [H8074] carries with it the meaning: *To stun; grow numb; devastate; stupefy*. Jesus, still teaching the disciples, taught that "as the days of Noah were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered into the ark, And knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be." Matt 24:37-39. (FS egw)

#### Conclusion—

Knowledge is not wisdom, and in and of itself, —<u>knowledge does not save!</u> Some seek to know these prophecies that they might <u>save themselves</u>, and fail to understand the wisdom of the saving power of Christ who gave the prophecies. Knowing these prophecies alone, without having a personal relationship with their Author, <u>will not save one's soul</u>. Belief in Jesus as the slain Lamb of God, —saves! Rev 5:6, 9. Yet, on the other hand, prophecy is given to reveal Jesus and His saving plan of redemption. Rev 1:3. Wisdom is the proper use of knowledge when

## All must make the decision, Who will they worship?

The choice is simple. Will we pay homage to the god who set up the **Sun**—day as his worship day (the image and mark of the beast; Rev 13)? **OR** Will we worship the Creator who made the seventh-day Sabbath for us (Rev 4:11; 10:6; 14:7; 7:14)? God foresaw that after sin, we would need to receive His Sabbath's sanctifying blessing (Gen 2:1-3; Ex 20:8-11; Lev 23), and thus receive the **seal** of His salvation. (Eze 20:12, 20; Rev 7:1-3; 9:4, 5.)

**Desolation(s)**; **Desolate**— The following is from *Strong's Hebrew Concordance*. **H8074** shamem (shaw-mame') v.

1. to stun (or intransitively, grow numb), i.e. devastate or (figuratively) stupefy (both usually in a passive sense)

Time Appointed— The following is from Strong's Hebrew Concordance.

H4150 מוֹעָדָה mow`ed (mo-ade') (or moled {mo-ade'} or (feminine) moweadah (2Chronicles 8:13–solemn feasts) n-m.

- 2. (specifically) a festival
